Registration: Online at **PRE-REG.** Race fee is \$35; \$25 for 19-29 years, and only \$5 for Juniors. Online registration closes at midnight, June 13th. Onsite fees increase by \$5 on the day of the race. Onsite registration opens at 7:00am on both days. All fields get NC State Medals, 3 deep, for annual USA Cycling license holders that have "NC" on license. Cash prizes go to overall finishers.

USAC Rules: All USA Cycling rules apply. Refer to www.usacycling.org for more details. All competitors must submit a signed USAC standard release form and present a valid license to race registrar in order to race. One-day USAC licenses for Juniors, Cat 5 Men, and Cat 4 Women races will be sold on site for \$15.

Other stuff: CPSC certified helmets required for all races, including warm up and cool down rides. No aero bars. No sleeveless jerseys. Centerline rule will be strictly enforced. Water bottles, wrappers, and all other litter may not be discarded in parking lots or on the course, or outside the designated feed zone. Anyone discarding litter outside the designated feed zone will be disqualified. Wheels in, Wheels out, if available. Races will be held rain or shine. Once follow vehicle has passed a dropped racer, rider is obliged to obey all North Carolina traffic laws. RACE DIRECTOR: Mike Thomas (910) 723-4052

Course. The course is a 17.5 mile clockwise loop in eastern Cumberland County. It is generally flat, with some rolling terrain. There is one overpass, and one bump into Wade, about 1.5 miles from the Finish Line.

MapMyRIDE (Juniors U-14 course is a 15 mile lollipop.)

Race Feed Zone: Feeding will be allowed after the end of the 2nd lap for races of 3 laps or more. There will be no feeding for 2 lap races. The feed zone will be near start / finish. All trash, bottles, and other items may be discarded only in the feed zone. Right of yellow/centerline rule in effect except for the last 200 meters.
