While obtaining his Ph.D. at Penn State University, Mark was the principal researcher on a project that provided the first empirical proof in the United States of the cost, schedule, and quality benefits of using design-build. He is a Designated Design-Build Professional (DBIA) and a LEED Accredited Professional. Outside of work Mark coaches a nationally competing girls hockey team in Maryland.
