LOCATION

At the very centre of the Polynesian triangle, the Cook Islands group consists of 15 islands scattered across 2 million square kilometres of the Pacific Ocean.

Pacific Blue - operate regular services out of New Zealand, with connecting flights from Australia.


Air Rarotonga - operates weekly code share services in conjunction with Air Tahiti from Papeete (Tahiti).
