You've seen them on the highway, they're high, wide, long and impressive.

They're OVERSIZE LOADS being transported to highway projects, construction sites and wind farms, and each of these present a hazard for the motorist.

Escorting many of these loads are vehicles known as Pilot Cars, equipped with OVERSIZE LOAD signs and flashing amber lights.

We have the task of keeping both you and the load safe as it moves down the road.

Our job often involves maneuvers that may catch you off-guard, like sudden lane changes and blocking off traffic to allow the loads to navigate bridges, curves and other hazards you may not be aware of.
