The results are starting to show: Balfour Beatty Construction reported a company-wide Recordable Incident Rate of 0.7 for 2009, compared to the previous year's rate of 1.35, which was 70 percent better than industry average.

"Hank truly embodies our Zero Harm philosophy," says Mark Reed, senior vice president with Balfour Beatty Construction. "He treats all employees, subcontracting partners, and vendors as if they were family. Everyone on the jobsite is someone's son, daughter, father, mother, husband, or wife, and Hank feels personally responsible for making sure they go home safely to their families every night."

As Doug Jones, division president and CEO offers, "Hank has a real passion for rallying our project teams to ensure that every worker on our sites gets home safely every day. It's a difficult job to be the safety 'auditor' and also be seen as a project team partner, but he balances these roles well.
