Dr. Ian Dunbar Biography

Dr. Ian Dunbar PhD, BVetMed, MRCVS, is a veterinarian, animal behaviorist, and writer. He received his veterinary degree from the Royal Veterinary College in London and a doctorate in animal behavior from the University of California in Berkeley, where he spent ten years researching behavior, social structure and aggression in domestic dogs.

Dr. Dunbar is a member of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons, the American Veterinary Society of Animal Behavior, the California Veterinary Medical Association, the Sierra Veterinary Medical Association, and the Association of Pet Dog Trainers (which he founded).

He has written numerous books, including *How To Teach A New Dog Old Tricks*, *The Good Little Dog Book*. Additionally, he has hosted eleven award-winning videos on puppy/dog behavior and training, including *SIRIUS® Puppy Training*, *Training Dogs With Dunbar* and *Every Picture Tells A Story*. He also created and hosted the popular British television program *Dogs with Dunbar*.

He founded the world's first pet dog puppy training classes in 1981, when he started SIRIUS® Puppy Training in the San Francisco Bay Area. The SIRIUS video and the puppy classes revolutionized the way that pet dogs were trained, questioning the need for aversive and often ineffective punishment, and popularizing lure/reward, off-leash training techniques that were much more enjoyable for people and dogs alike. Dr. Dunbar was invited to develop and write (for over seven years) the American Kennel Club's Gazette "Behavior" column, which was voted Best Dog Column for a number of years in succession by the Dog Writers' Association of America.

In 1993, Dr. Dunbar founded the Association of Pet Dog Trainers (APDT) in the United States and organized the first two Annual Conferences. He has given over a thousand seminars to veterinarians, dog trainers and pet owners around the world. There are very few educated trainers who have not been strongly influenced by Dr. Dunbar's fun & games, from-the-animal's-point-of-view, dog friendly dog training.

Dr. Dunbar is peerless in his field; there is simply no other person who has his qualifications, experience, and expertise in the realm of modern psychological dog training and behavior counseling-fields which Dr. Dunbar has played a major role in developing over the past 40 years.
