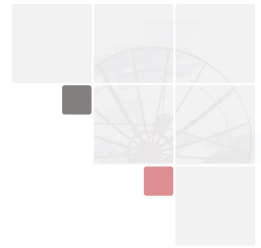


Preventive Measures While travelling to Brazil (Basics)

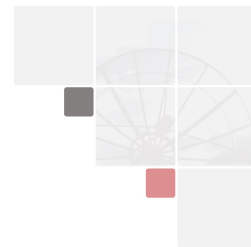


Taxies

- Prefer a known taxi services company; (Don't use the same company all the time)
- Never enter to taxi with other passengers.
- Stop a random taxi; don't let the driver offer his service to you.
- Don't enter to taxi whom her driver stop on his own.
- When in the taxi don't give information about who you are, where you are going to etc.
- Prepare payment in advance don't open your wallet looking for the exact amount.
- Avoid talking about highly important issues regarding the company activities.
- When traveling in the city - Keep the windows closed.
- Always seat at the back rather than beside the driver.
- Keep your luggage's on the baggage of the car and not beside you. Enter the car verify that the rear baggage is closed and your luggage are in only then close your door and ask the driver to take you to your destination.

At the street

- Don't show off expensive items such as watch, jewelries, etc.
 - If not necessary avoid walking with your laptop or important documents.
 - Look for away to minimize the amounts you are carrying with you. Deposit your credit card, or any other expensive items, on the hotel safe or other trusted location. Always walk with the amount you need for your specific activity.
 - If you need to carry your credit card with you don't keep it in your wallet. If any criminal activity is happening give your wallet with no important items in it.(Necessary important items should be kept hidden)
 - Make a copy of your passport. Deposit your original passport at the hotel safe.
 - Try to avoid carrying documents that indicate "How important you are" such as business cards with your title, VIP club member etc.
 - Know where the high risk regions are, don't go there.
 - When in the street prefer walking on groups rather than alone. Avoid walking on "deserted" streets prefer places with activity, areas where security could be shown etc.
 - Prefer traveling at day time rather than night.
 - Avoid opening your luggage in a public place.
 - Avoid writing your name and position on your luggage.
 - Don't let any one carry your luggage's, when in the airport, hotel etc)

Possible criminal activity upon you?

- Cooperate, keep calm, give him what he want, don't try to resist, argue or convince the attacker to leave you – it will only make him more nervous. The main target of most of the criminal activities is money/materials, and in most cases will be over fast.

Hotel

- Prefer hotel located on a safe region and with relatively good level of security.
- Reserve room, which is on the 7 floor or higher. (Criminal activities upon hotels are usually directed to the firsts floors)
- Don't open the door to an unknown person. Always confirm who is behind the door .(Pipe hole)
- Don't except deliveries, flowers etc , if you are not expecting them.
- Don't open the door to room service unless you ordered one. Even when ordered confirm using the pipe hole.

Telephones numbers

- Keep with you all important phone numbers such as: Main contact person at the location, Local police, Ambulance, Hotel, Credit card emergency number, Embassy etc.
- Program two quick dial ups.
