Over 2.5 Million Meals Served - 2.65 Million Articles of Clothing Distributed to the Needy and Over 100,000 Lives Changed

Established 1986 Spectacular Ministries of the Lords' Servants to minister to the incarcerated at the Utah State Prison, and then in 1993 the Salt Lake City Mission branch which was established to help the homeless disenfranchised and poor become independent, productive members of society through a life centered in Jesus Christ. The Salt Lake City Mission staff, management and board are committed to helping all people who have a genuine need and depravation, regardless of race, creed, religion, age or national origin. The Salt Lake City Mission provides emergency services and long-term recovery programs; we help meet the physical, mental, educational and spiritual needs of families, children and individuals.

FACTS AT A GLANCE 2012 - 2013 Fiscal Year

During this past year, The Salt Lake City Mission has provided blessings to the community as follows:

- > Watched over 848 people make faith decisions for Christ.
- Served over 211,482 meals to the destitute and needy of Utah throughout this year.
- Provided Breakfast Monday Saturday behind Road Home Men's, Women's and family shelters, from our portable kitchen unit, serving 3,619 meals a week, over 15,634 meals a month and over 187,609 a year.
- Held special "All Day Outreaches" at Pioneer Park, on Easter, Memorial Day and on Labor Day, serving over 13,340 hot prepared meals at these events.
- > Provided 921 Turkey Baskets for Thanksgiving with all the trimmings to destitute families in need.
- Served a "Delicious" Thanksgiving Dinner to over 4,000 at Energy Solutions Arena The Tuesday before Thanksgiving
- > On Thanksgiving Day served a "Delicious" Thanksgiving Dinner to over 1,894 at "The Christian Life Center"
- > Provided 1,400 Households with Christmas Boxes, including Turkey's, Ham's, Trimmings & Toys with Eagle Ranch.
- > Distributed over 3,501 pantry style meals in food boxes to needy families.
- On Christmas Day served over 2,214 "Delicious" Christmas Dinners. We also over 2,250 wrapped Christmas presents to needy and homeless children.
- > On New Year's Day served 2,425 "Delicious" New Year's Meals with the help of 400 volunteers assisting.
- > Provided 41,237 people with over 424,681 pieces of clothing, household goods, furniture and appliances.
- > Graduated 12 men to self-sufficiency from our Long-Term Recovery Programs.
- Watched 3 men in our *Recovery Programs* received their Associates Degrees; 2 men received their Bachelor's Degrees through the Sure Foundation Theological Seminary.
- > Conducted more than 3,500 counseling sessions to needy souls.
- > Provided co-pays for hearing aids, eyeglasses and prescription medication for our clients.
- > Facilitated GED's, Vocational Rehabilitation assistance and college for homeless people.
- > Through "Salt Lake City Street News," created over 265 active self-employment opportunities for the homeless.
- Conducted over 26,720 hours of Bible Studies, Life Skills Classes, Group Sessions & Counseling Sessions
- Received encouragement and support from over 2,249 Volunteers that performed over 349,093 hours of service to the needy and destitute throughout the year.
