

Peter Max, whose bold colors and uplifting images are instantly recognizable and admired worldwide, has had a love affair with America since he arrived in the country as a young boy from China. Beginning with the U.S. Bicentennial celebration in 1976, Peter Max has created unique paintings of the Statute of Liberty each Fourth of July to celebrate the patriotic symbol of the freedom and independence that Americans enjoy. Over the years, he has celebrated Independence Day with world leaders ranging from The King of Sweden, President Ford, and incoming President Jimmy Carter in 1976; to President Ronald Reagan and Nancy Reagan in 1981; and President Bill Clinton in 2000.

Max's passion for America and the Fourth of July holiday has continued and grown over the years. Peter has celebrated the holiday in one of his favorite places for more than a decade – the New Jersey seaside community of Stone Harbor. 
