Oil and Solar Mix on Main Street

Old and New Finally Working Together - Providing up to \$2,500 in Oil Fuel Credits

WEST WARWICK, RI, Sept 28, 2016 – Valley Fuel and Warwick Oil are teaming up with WattSun Solar to form the *first* oil-solar partnership in New England: **Kent County Saves**.

The **Kent County Saves** program is a grassroots initiative aimed at residents who qualify for solar incentives but don't realize it. **Kent County Saves'** unique plan is designed to help the community hedge against rising utility costs by owning their own renewable energy system and getting paid for it, not only through local and federal solar incentives, but \$500-\$2,500 in additional Valley Fuel credits for home heating (*Incentives pursuant to Title 39 Chapter 26.6 Rhode Island General Law**). Upfront expenses for each Solar Power System are paid by program financing partners and then recouped with incentive payments made by their utility company.

The **Kent County Saves** program launches this Friday at the grand opening and open house of WattSun Solar's new location in the Valley Fuel/Warwick Oil building on Main Street, and is open to the public.
