MTA FAMILY makes it easy for a Parent to add a family member's photo and voice to be used to teach your Toddler to first associate a text name to a person and ultimately to help them learn to spell. The family member's voice will tell their Toddler how to spell their name while it displays across the screen one letter at a time.




MTA ANIMALS allows the family to choose from over 40 animals to present to their Toddler. The family's voice will tell their Toddler how to spell the animals name while it displays across the screen one letter at a time. Once the audio completes the Toddler is invited to touch the animal to hear the sound they make.

MTA MATCH is memory building game that you customize to your toddler. They can use your own photos or two different pre-loaded image libraries to play the game. It includes four different difficulty levels to help your toddler develop their memory skills.



MTA READER provides an easy to use app for your Toddler to watch pre-recorded book readings. Any family member can record themselves reading a book and then load it into MTA READER. The Toddler then just has to touch the book cover on their main screen to enjoy the book. Grandma living in another state can read a book and transfer it to their Toddlers iPad using iTunes.
