Bill Monroe Museum launches crowdfunding campaign to reach operational completion

Rosine, KY: With ground having been broken on May 22nd, the Bill Monroe Museum is becoming reality. Today, the Bill Monroe Museum launched a fundraising campaign on the crowdfunding platform Indiegogo. This is in response to a need for funds to finish the build-out of the inside of the building. While the building itself is fully funded and construction is not in question, there remains no budget to fill the museum with displays, exhibits, furniture, and to perform some much-needed restoration on delicate items. *Donors will enjoy tax-deductible contributions* and, because of the use of the crowdfunding format, many exciting bluegrass-specific perks (rewards) will be distributed based on donation level.

Of the campaign, Ohio County Tourism Commission Executive Director and overseer of the Bill Monroe Museum project, Jody Flener said, "We need to fundraise because it's time to go inside the museum now. We need to restore memorabilia that we've had for over 13 years. We need the display cases, the lighting, the things that will really make the (Bill Monroe) Museum special and a unique experience.
