I have also published translations of medieval philosophical treatises from the Arabic, Sanskrit languages with commentaries, introductory articles and notes; and translations of several scientific articles in Indian philosophy from the English and German language. E.g.:

- 1) from Sanskrit – the translation of “Vedarthasamgraha”, “Sharanagatigadya” (Ramanuja), “Gitarthasamgraha”, “Atmasiddhi” (Yamuna) etc. from the Sanskrit language. Published in Moscow.
- 2) from Arabic – the translation of “Kitab al-mawaqif”, “Kitab al-Mukhatabat” (an-Niffary, published in Moscow 2020), Halim Barakat’s “Tair al-haum” (published in Moscow 2007) etc. from the Arabic language.
- 3) from English – the translation of Jack Harte’s “Reflections in Tar-Barrel” (Published in 2020, nominated in Ireland as one of the best translations).
- 4) From German – the translation of Gerhard Oberhammer’s articles. Published in 2016-2020.
