Abstraction is my inquiry into the nature of life. As a painter, I am fascinated by the emotional power of music and poetry. From the painting platforms of color and visual space, I am exploring universal currents and rhythms. Fluid acrylic paints are the best medium for me to invent forms and shapes that convey energy and movement on the canvas. The work reflects a luminous depth contrasted with a rich surface texture. My current body of work represents an investigation of inner and outer space. The observer is invited to relate to these "visual song-poems" as joyous expressions of life.
