









No Research About Us Without Us.


We are friends, allies, and members of the disability community. We want the places we live, work, play, learn and worship to be equitable. And we want a nation where health equity is available for all.




We know that many people with disabilities have been left out of or hurt by health research in the past. This is why health care providers know less about our health. All of Us wants to change that by following best practices.




