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Roots Music Rambler Launches New Website, Backstage Pass Community and Artist Services

A deeper home for Americana and roots music stories connects listeners with interviews, bonus access and new ways for artists to share their work

LOUISVILLE, Ky. and CHICAGO — Roots Music Rambler, the podcast exploring the people and places behind Americana, country, bluegrass, blues, folk and more, has launched a refreshed [website](#) alongside its Backstage Pass Patreon community and a new slate of artist services. The combined expansion gives music fans an easier way to discover the show and gives independent artists more ways to turn their stories into lasting content.

The new site brings the [podcast and interview archive](#), video clips and road stories into a more navigable home. Listeners can follow an artist conversation from a full episode to shorter moments and related discoveries, then subscribe on their preferred podcast platform. Hosted by Francesca “Frank” Folinazzo and Jason “Falls” Falls, the show favors unhurried conversations about songwriting, creative roots and the communities that shape a sound.

That approach has brought a wide range of guests to the mic, including [S.G. Goodman](#), [Hunter Flynn](#), [John Horton of Son Volt and The Bottle Rockets](#), [Tanner Horton of The Creekers](#) and [Shawn Camp](#). Their episodes span emerging voices, alt-country history, viral bluegrass and veteran songwriting, showing the range of the growing catalog.

For listeners who want more, [Backstage Pass](#) opens a community on Patreon. Joining the community is free; the \$5-per-month paid tier offers early access to new episodes, an ad-free feed, exclusive outtakes and interview segments, bonus reviews and planned travel guides, and 15% off the Roots Music Rambler store. Membership is optional, and the public podcast remains available to all.

The expansion also introduces [artist services](#) for musicians seeking stronger media and digital assets. Offerings include a coordinated content-production package, electronic press kits, targeted media outreach, interview coaching, and artist websites with search optimization. Artists and their teams can inquire about a tailored scope.
