
Each spread introduces another crazy idea complete with floor


"Talk to Me of Love" combines drawings and love poems. All are of women I have encountered at various times in my life. Some relationships






ones. It's surprising how many people can't strike a simple, natural pose. So, bless the ones that do. I love drawing people, the most challenging of all drawing assignments.




"Drawings of Stuff" is a book for anyone who enjoys the shear pleasure of looking at well executed drawings. There's something so
