To be reimbursed, Player2Go members must send their proof of purchase to V-Burny.com by January 31, 2008.

Player2Go is available on an annual subscription basis: Premium members (£15) can keep the MP3/MP4 player as long as they want, and Basic members (£10) up to 10 days.

The service is also available on a Pay-As-You-Go basis for £3.99 and the portable player can be kept up to 10 days. Customers can transfer the audiobook on their computer or burn onto CD when they receive the player. Postage is free both ways.
